





From the majestic mountain views and serene village streets to the grandeur of the Great Estates, this region offers a perfect blend of history and tranquility. Explore Hyde Park's historic charm, Rhinebeck's allure and Red Hook's quaint character, all set against the rolling farmlands of Clinton, Milan, Pleasant Valley and Stanford — a true escape into nature and culture.





NOT TO BE MISSED

Start your day with a peaceful stroll through Beatrix Farrand Garden at Bellefield (Hyde Park), located on the grounds of the Home of Franklin D. Roosevelt National Historic Site. Northern Dutchess is also home to two additional national parks: Vanderbilt Mansion National Historic Site and **Eleanor Roosevelt National Historic** Site (pg. 37).







SUSTAINABLE SIPS

Plan Bee Farm Brewery

(Poughkeepsie) sources 100% of its ingredients from NYS. Many come from the farm itself, including blueberries, strawberries, dandelion flowers, dill pickles and honeycomb.

TRY THIS: Pepper, a farmhouse sour made with a mix of farm-grown hot peppers

Branchwater Farms (Milan) employs regenerative agriculture techniques (no-till, composting, cover crops etc.) to restore vitality and nutrient density to their soil. Their heritage crops like Danko rye, Red Fife wheat and Bloody Butcher corn — fuel whiskeys, brandies and a triple-distilled gin.

TRY THIS: Branchwater Rye Whiskey

Taste Dutchess terroir at Milea Estate Vineyard's (Staatsburg) living vine library; the Hudson Valley Heritage Wines project conserves indigenous grape varietals and cultivars bred from European and Native American grapes centuries ago. Wines can be produced more sustainably from grapes that thrive in the local climate.

TRY THIS: 2023 Hudson Heritage Vidal Blanc

FRESH PICKS = FRESH POURS

C.Cassis (Rhinebeck) harnesses Dutchess County black currants for a delicious all-natural liqueur with lemon verbena and honey. Visit their chic tasting room and bottle shop for snacks, spritzes and cocktails celebrating black currants.

TRY THIS: Achilles High Heel, a cocktail with C.Cassis, gin, Lillet Blanc, mint and grappa-soaked cranberry

A rainbow of orchard-harvested fruit often finds its way into new releases from Rose Hill Ferments (Red Hook). Their flagship cider Kitchen Sink uses exclusively Rose Hill Farm heirloom and bittersweet apples, while takes

on old-world beverages like Pearly Dewdrops utilize fresh stonefruit.

TRY THIS: Sundrops, a pét nat sparkling fruit wine made from yellow Shiro plums

Taste with your eyes first at **Hudson** Valley Brewery (Beacon), where fruitforward sour IPAs burst with color and have equally-fun tasting descriptions that elicit feelings of nostalgia think Peach Rings, Black Forest cake or Hubba Bubba Gum. Also sample stouts, lagers, ciders and naturally fermented wines at this modern tasting room.

TRY THIS: Bloom, a Sour Double IPA with wheat and oat, milk sugar, cherries, dark chocolate and chamomile

CONNECT WITH NATURE

Explore **Tivoli Bays**, a large intertidal marsh on the NYS Birding Trail with woodland paths, boardwalk trails and kayak launches. Participate in an **Appalachian Trail** thruhiker tradition by hugging the **Dover Oak**, the largest tree of its kind in the U.S. Walk looped trails through **Vlei Marsh** (Rhinebeck), a vast wetland with a variety of wildlife and quirky sculptures made by Hudson Valley artists.

ADA WHEELCHAIR-ACCESSIBLE TRAILS

Woodland Trail at Stony Kill Farm, Harlem Valley Rail Trail, MJM Northside Line, Maybrook Trailway, Dutchess Rail Trail, Walkway Over the Hudson State Park

REACH NEW HEIGHTS

Summit Millerton's majestic **Brace Mountain**, the tallest peak in Dutchess County (2,311 feet above sea level). Fans of fire tower hikes, ascend to the top of **Ferncliff Forest** in Rhinebeck; or, climb **Stissing Mountain** in Pine Plains for views of five surrounding states. For a physical challenge, climb **Mount Beacon** to soak in views of Beacon, the Hudson River and the surrounding Hudson Highlands.

PATHS THROUGH HISTORY

Hike to **Dover Stone Church**, a breathtaking cathedral-shaped entrance to a cave where Chief Sassacus and his warriors hid during The Pequot War. Walk the **Farm Lane Trail** in Hyde Park that connects FDR's **Springwood** and Eleanor Roosevelt's **Val-Kill Cottage**. Legend has it Washington Irving came up with the name Rip Van Winkle while strolling around **Poets' Walk Park**. The short boardwalk trail at **Madam Brett Park** (named for the first European settler in Beacon) brushes past the historic 1879 Tioranda Hatworks factory.

OUTDOOR RECREATION

GOLF: Play rounds with rich history at **Dinsmore Golf Course** (Staatsburg) — the third-oldest golf course in the country, found in Mills-Norrie State Park and Dutcher Golf Course (Pawling), the oldest nine-hole municipal golf course in the nation. Scenic rounds await at "18 holes of Ireland in Dutchess County" at The Links at Union Vale as well as McCann Memorial Golf Course (Poughkeepsie), and Red Hook Golf Club, which offers outdoor dining at The Grove.



= **DISC GOLF:** Play multiple layouts for up to 24 holes at Beacon Glades Disc Golf Course, designed around an abandoned summer camp with beautiful mountain views. Hackett Hill (Hyde Park) is a dynamic ninehole wooded course, while Tymor Park's nine-hole layout in LaGrangeville features wide-open fairways. For a challenge, tackle the PDGA-rated 27-hole course and campgrounds at Wilcox Memorial Park (Stanfordville).

PICKLEBALL: Quiet Cove Riverfront Park (Poughkeepsie) has four gorgeous pickleball courts, including an ADA-accessible court for wheelchairusing players. Play at James Baird State Park (Pleasant Valley) with several courts amidst robust sports activities and trails, including an educational playground. Staatsburg's Dinsmore Park features three outdoor courts, and Hudson Valley Pickleball and Golf Center (Poughkeepsie) has

options indoors.

CAMPING: For novice campers with no gear or car, Malouf's Mountain Campground (Beacon) supplies everything needed for a rustic getaway. Reserve one of the tent platform sites at The Rudd Pond Area at Taconic State Park (Millerton) for views of the Taconic Mountain Range. Immersive stays await inside Mills-Norrie State Park (Staatsburg), including 46 campsites with boating, crosscountry skiing and more. Families will love the amenities and games at Sylvan Lake Beach Park (Hopewell Junction).

Campers, look up! 2025 is the anticipated peak of the current solar cycle, meaning more opportunities to see the Northern Lights in Dutchess (plus, watch summer meteor showers like the Perseids and Southern Delta Aquariids).



SAILING & CRUISES: Sail aboard the Hudson River Sloop Clearwater — a faithful replica of a 19thcentury Dutch vessel co-founded by folk music legend and environmental activist Pete Seeger. Trips are engaging, educational and scenic. Nothing But Time Sailing Charters (Poughkeepsie) serves champagne with sunsets on a 40-foot sailing yacht.

PADDLING: Paddle through Tivoli Bays, along the shoreline of Franklin D. Roosevelt's Springwood estate and Vanderbilt Mansion, or to Bannerman Castle with The River Connection. Hudson River Expeditions launches explorations of Fishkill Creek and Denning's Point at Scenic Hudson's Long Dock Park, just a short walk away from Beacon train station.


FISH & GAME: Learn fly fishing or wingshooting from skilled instructors at **Orvis Sandanona's** (Millbrook) renowned schools and 400 acres of placid casting ponds and trout streams. Enjoy a round of sporting clays or upland hunting at the oldest permitted shotgun-shooting club in the country. Running along Route 22, the Ten Mile River offers breathtaking fishing spots and is stocked annually with 9,000 brown trout. Rent a boat from The Lake House on Wappingers Lake for largemouth bass and chain pickerel.

BIKING: Pedal through iconic Hudson Valley landmarks like the Walkway Over the Hudson and the Hopewell Depot Museum along the William R. Steinhaus Dutchess Rail Trail. Bike shops and rental facilities include Bikeway (Wappingers Falls and Beacon) and City Bike Rentals PK (Poughkeepsie), as well as Pedego (Beacon) for electric bike rentals.

The Path to Independence

America will celebrate a major anniversary on July 4, 2026, marking 250 years since the signing of the Declaration of Independence in 1776.

Because of its strategic location on the Hudson River, Dutchess County played a pivotal role in the Revolutionary War. During the ongoing Rev250 celebration, be sure to visit these Dutchess County sites with ties to the American Revolution.

CLERMONT STATE HISTORIC SITE (Germantown)

The Livingston home was burned in 1777 by the British because of the family's Patriot ties and was immediately rebuilt. Judge Robert R. Livingston was a member of the Stamp Act Congress. Henry Beekman Livingston was colonel of the Fourth New York Regiment. Chancellor Robert R. Livingston was a member of the Continental Congress and helped draft the Declaration of Independence.

MOUNT GULIAN HISTORIC SITE* (Beacon)

Roughly 8,000 years of history are documented at the Verplanck family homestead, dating back to the indigenous people who lived on the property. Mount Gulian's residents made important contributions to the Revolution, the Abolitionist Movement, the Civil War and more. The home served as Revolutionary War headquarters of General Friedrich Von Steuben, whose European training methods were vital to George Washington's inexperienced soldiers. Von Steuben helped form America's first veterans' organization, the Society of the Cincinnati, at Mount Gulian in 1783.

VAN WYCK HOMESTEAD MUSEUM* (Fishkill)

The Continental Army used the Van Wyck family's house as the officers' headquarters for the Fishkill Supply Depot, a key strategic center visited repeatedly by General Washington.

JOHN KANE HOUSE* (Pawling)

For three months in 1778, General George Washington based his military movements in Pawling and slept in the home of John and Sybil Kane, which is now a museum. First-floor exhibits share details about Washington's use of Pawling and about the area's indigenous and European settlers. Upstairs, learn about more recent Pawling history, including details about John Lorimer Worden, a Dutchess native and a U.S. Navy Commander during the American Civil War, who is buried in Pawling.

MESIER HOMESTEAD AND MUSEUM (Wappingers Falls)

The homestead is said to be the site of The Wappinger Tea Party of 1777. Learn about Daniel Nimham, the last Sachem of the indigenous Wappinger people, who fought alongside the Continental Army and was killed at the Battle of Kingsbridge.

BEEKMAN ARMS & DELAMATER INN (Rhinebeck)

During the war, the Fourth Regiment of the Continental Army performed drills on the lawn. Guests included George Washington, Benedict Arnold, Aaron Burr and Alexander Hamilton. Established in 1766, "America's Oldest Continuously Operated Inn" offers a choice of 80 rooms and a welcoming tavern.

HISTORY'S TAPESTRY

Step back into Dutchess County's past and discover the fascinating stories of the people who defined our history and built our community.

19th Century

Locust Grove Estate* (Poughkeepsie): Explore an Italianate-style mansion, landscaped gardens and miles of trails at the one-time summer retreat of telegraph inventor Samuel F. B. Morse.

Wilderstein Historic Site* (Rhinebeck): This Queen Anne-style Victorian house on the Hudson was the home of FDR's cousin and confidant, Margaret "Daisy" Suckley. Discover more: Montgomery Place at Bard College (Annandale-on-Hudson); Edgewater (Barrytown); Brinckerhoff House Historic Site (East Fishkill).

Gilded Age

Staatsburgh State Historic Site (Staatsburg): The country home of Ogden and Ruth Livingston Mills, this 79-room mansion was once a social hub for America's elite.

Vanderbilt Mansion National Historic Site (Hyde Park): This 54-room country home of railroad baron Frederick William Vanderbilt and his wife, Louise, epitomized the extravagance of the aristocracy in the Gilded Age.

Turn of the Century

Bannerman Castle* (Beacon): Enjoy a scenic boat ride to Pollepel Island in the Hudson River and explore the ruins of this Scottishstyle castle built by military surplus dealer Francis Bannerman to store his vast inventory. Visit the island for events like theatrical performances, concerts, movie nights and farm-to-table dinners.

Old Rhinebeck Aerodrome* (Red Hook): Home to the world's second-oldest regularly flying airplane and a flying reproduction of Charles Lindbergh's plane, The Spirit of St. Louis. Antique airshows take place on weekends in May through October. Book a flight in an open-cockpit 1929 biplane with an experienced pilot.

America's First Family:

THE ROOSEVELTS

Franklin and Eleanor Roosevelt were America's quintessential political power couple of the 20th century. He guided the nation out of the Great Depression and through World War II. She played a leading role in the writing of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

Visit these landmarks on the Roosevelt estate in Hyde Park:

- Home of Franklin D. Roosevelt National Historic Site (Springwood): The home where our 32nd president was born. Visit Franklin and Eleanor's gravesites in the rose garden.
- FDR Presidential Library and Museum: America's first presidential library.
- Eleanor Roosevelt National Historic Site* (Val-Kill): The only National Historic Site dedicated to a first lady.
- Top Cottage: FDR's secluded retreat.

GALLERIES AND VISUAL ARTS

Dia Beacon displays a vast range of contemporary art inside a large former Nabisco box-printing plant on the Hudson. Don't miss Louise Bourgeois' Crouching Spider, Richard Serra's winding steel sculptures and a new multi-media installation from director Steve McQueen — plus, works from Andy Warhol.

Continue your Beacon gallery crawl with a stroll through Marion Royael's gallery and outdoor installation. Tour The KuBe Art Center inside the former Beacon high school for exhibitions, workshops and pottery classes through SilicaStudio845. Distortion Society + Tattoo combines art gallery and tattoo parlor, while Super Secret Gallery is a hidden treasure inside boutique Hyperbole.

Frances Lehman Loeb Art Center on the Vassar College campus offers free admission and its collection houses 22,000 pieces that span centuries. Highlights are paintings by masters like Henri Matisse, Pablo Picasso, Georgia O'Keeffe, Jackson Pollock and the Hudson River School painters. Also free to enter, browse CCS Bard's Hessel Museum of Art on the Bard College campus.

Climb through the seven stories of multi-media art installations and exhibits by creators-in-residence at The Wassaic Project (Wassaic), housed in a repurposed historic grain elevator. Explore the Entheon at Chapel of Sacred Mirrors (Wappingers Falls) for celestial and psychedelic art and events. Forty local painters, sculptors, animators, photographers and more comprise Tivoli Artists Gallery, which began as a holiday crafts fair in 1989.

Check out The Art League of Hyde Park and Poughkeepsie's walking map to find outdoor art, including murals by Riiisa Boogie, Franc Palaia and Nèstor Madalengoitia.

Stissing Center for Arts & Culture (Pine Plains) This atmospheric oasis offers world-class performances from the finest talent from near and far.

COMEDY

Laugh It Up Comedy Club (Poughkeepsie) Catch stand-up comedy's biggest names (Chris Rock, Akaash Singh) and up-and-comers in an intimate setting at Mahoney's Irish Pub.

MJN Convention Center (Poughkeepsie) A-list entertainers like Nate Bargatze, John Mulaney and Bert Kreischer perform new material to large crowds.







MUSIC AND ARTS FESTIVALS

Kaatsbaan Festival (Kaatsbaan Cultural Park, Tivoli) Kaatsbaan's sprawling artist sanctuary on the Hudson is an incubator for innovative dance, theater, music and visual arts; events and festivals celebrate the form on stunning outdoor stages. Ballet icon Mikhail Baryshnikov celebrated his 75th birthday in 2023 with a day of performances at Kaatsbaan, which hosts different artists from Baryshnikov Arts each year.

Bard SummerScape (Fisher Center at Bard College, Annandale-on-Hudson)

This multidisciplinary festival unites strong voices in opera, dance, theater, music, film and cabaret each summer. Grab a seat in the Spiegeltent, a glittering, mirrored tent-like pavilion that hosts live performances, drinks and dancing all summer. Running concurrently, the Bard Music Festival examines one composer each year through discussion and performance.

MODfest (Vassar College, Poughkeepsie) Experience a full week of dance, theater and visual arts at this free festival dedicated to exploring a theme through

20th and 21st century creatives.

Beacon Bonfire Music + Art Festival

Get cozy by one of the many campfires set during this annual festival of the arts throughout Beacon. Musicians, performance artists and other creatives showcase the wide variety of venues along Main Street.

Jazz in the Valley (Victor C. Waryas Park, Poughkeepsie) Sit along the Poughkeepsie waterfront as absolute legends of the jazz world take the stage. Local food trucks provide delectable fare.

Big Lawn Music Festival

(Plan Bee Farm Brewery, Poughkeepsie) This annual outdoor music festival features a lineup of more than a dozen acts from the Hudson Valley, New York City and beyond, in genres ranging from rock to indie to rap.

Meet more local talent at the community-fueled Poughkeepsie Porchfest and Rhinebeck Porchfest.



NIGHTLIFE

Happy Valley Arcade Bar (Beacon)

This groovy barcade features modern and retro machines, plus a varied calendar of drag shows, DJ sets and themed nights.

Reason and Ruckus (Poughkeepsie) EDM rave parties, punk-fueled emo nights and ramen pop-ups from Reconnect Foods await at this energetic hotspot on Main Street.

CLASSICAL

Howland Cultural Center (Beacon)

This striking 150-year-old building is a piece of art itself and a space for performance art, concerts by the Howland Chamber Music Circle, Beacon Litfest and a variety of creativity workshops.



MARIST UNIVERSITY (Poughkeepsie)

For one of the prettiest walks along the Hudson River, visit Longview Park at the edge of Marist University's beautiful campus. Shop at Mporium, a boutique run entirely by Marist fashion merchandising students, for curated collections of items featuring top trends in the marketplace. During the NY Stage and Film festival, artists like Laurence Fishburne and Margaret Cho premiered new works-in-progress.

DINING: For lunch, Lola's is a Marist University classic. With a little something for everyone, Lola's bowls, salads, paninis and wraps are great for dine-in or a graband-go picnic. For those craving pizza, their sister restaurant, Lolita's, specializes in Italian dishes with creative flair.





BARD COLLEGE (Annandale-on-Hudson)

Bard College stands on 1,000 scenic acres, which include the Bard Arboretum, 19thcentury walled Blithewood Garden and walking trails that reveal gorgeous views of the Catskill Mountains and **Montgomery Place** — the region's only surviving Federal Era estate house. Architect Frank Gehry designed the striking Fisher Center at the heart of campus. Visit in the warmer months to experience the Bard Music Festival and SummerScape, an eight-week-long festival of contemporary dance, theatrical performances and concerts at the Fisher Center and inside the boisterous Spiegeltent.



- 11. Find tranquility among nature's beauty with a mindful stroll through the breathtaking landscapes of Blithewood Garden (Annandale-On-Hudson).
- 12. Practice yoga alongside friendly llamas and alpacas while soaking in the scenic farm views at Clover Brooke Farm (Hyde Park). Llamaste!
