Dassai is made from 100% Yamada Nishiki rice, the gold standard of sake rice. Observe the brewing process through windows looking into various production rooms during the tour and tasting experience and sample Dassai Blue 50, the first sake brewed on-site.

Traditionally crafted hard cider made only with apples grown on this over 100-year-old family farm founded by Henry Morgenthau Jr., Secretary of the Treasury under Franklin D. Roosevelt. They grow 80 varieties, which are picked as late as possible, allowing more flavor to develop, then pressed in small batches on a traditional rack and cloth press.

The rye and more than 120 varieties of apples are grown on the farm. Open year-round for tours and tastings by appointment.

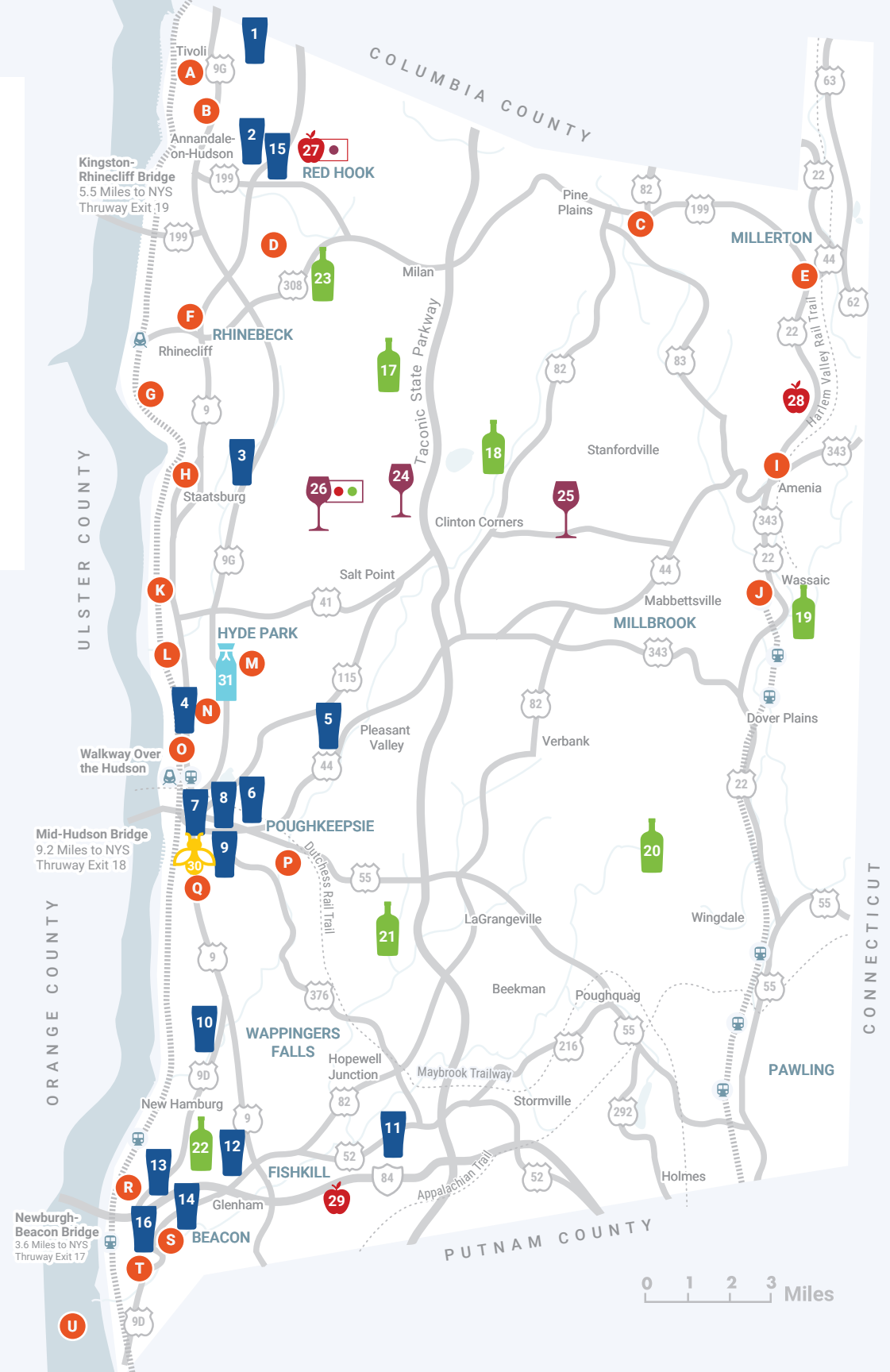
